Students will focus on the history, theology, culture, and times that enable Christianity to develop and grow. Prominent persons who impacted the Christian movement will be identified.

1007 Phase 1	Survey of the Old Testament Dr. Jimmy Bryant	This course will survey the Old Testament. Included in this survey will be a general overview of the divisions, time periods, places, events, people, and archaeology of the Old Testament.
1072 Phase 1	Survey of the New Testament Rev. Ernest King	This course will survey the New Testament. Included in this survey will be a general overview of the divisions, time periods, places, events, people, and archaeology of the New Testament.
1075 Phase 2	Synoptic Gospels Dr. W.M. Ramsey	Focus on the Synoptic gospels – Matthew, Mark and Luke. Students will study the life and ministry of Jesus Christ as portrayed by these three writers. Through this comparative study, students will gain a more comprehensive understanding of Jesus' ministry.
2007 Phase 2	Christian Stewardship Sister Angela M. Williams	Cover the basic tenets of Christian stewardshiptime, talent and tithe. Students will begin to understand how to effectively manage their resources through a better understanding of the spiritual principles, practices and contributions of Christian stewardship.
2023	Creative Ways of Teaching Dr. Venita B. Timpson	This course is designed to instruct in the methods of teaching in the local church setting. It is designed to assist teachers in discovering new ways of teaching, such as learning behaviors and strategies of student learning and behavior.
4012 Phase 2	The Doctrine of the Holy Spirit Rev. Woodrow Jenkins	Students will study the person and work of the Holy Spirit.
