FEC Congress of Christian Education

Morning Courses/Seminars – 7:50 a.m. – 10:10 a.m.

Course # 1089, Phase 3 - ***Survey of Romans*** – Dr. Howard Barr

This course will focus on a thematic overview of the major issues presented in Paul's doctrinal letter to the Roman Christians. Students will come to recognize each doctrinal truth presented in the book.

Course # 1094 – ***Survey of Ephesians*** – Dr. W.M. Ramsey

This course will focus on the book of Ephesians with emphasis on the authorship, date, and recipients of this letter. This letter, while confirming the role of Christ in the church, also highlights responsible Christian living and unity in Christ. This course will be taught in conjunction with the Survey of Philippians.

Course # 1095 – ***Survey of Philippians*** -Dr. W.M. Ramsey

This course will focus on the book of Philippians with emphasis on the authorship, date, and recipients of this letter. The main theme of the letter is rejoicing in the Lord. This letter will be taught in conjunction with the Survey of Ephesians.

Course # 1096 – ***Survey of Colossians*** - Deacon William McGill

This course will focus on the book of Colossians with emphasis on the authorship, date, and recipients of this letter. It defends the Gospel against false teachings and gives encouragement for the Christian life. This course will be taught in conjunction with the Survey of Philemon.

Course # 1100 – ***Survey of Philemon*** – Deacon William McGill

This course will focus on the book of Philemon with emphasis on the authorship, date, and recipients of this letter. It puts Christian ethics into practice. It also reveals the transforming power of salvation in the life of a slave who found the Lord Jesus Christ. This course will be taught in conjunction with the Survey of Colossians.

Course # 4012, Phase 2 – ***Doctrine of the Holy Spirit*** – Dr. Ricki Gardner

Students will study the person and work of the Holy Spirit. This study will include a thorough look at the corresponding doctrine that impacts our understanding of the work of the Holy Spirit. The students will be able to clearly identify this doctrine of the church with holistic. Understanding salvation, with special emphasis on justification, redemption, and sanctification.

Course # 6013, Phase 4 – ***Organizing the Church for Christian Education*** -
Valerie Brant-Wilson

This course will focus on the various administrative and organizational skills needed to organize the Christian education department. Students will focus on structure, leadership and staffing needs for Christian Education.

Course # 8066, Phase 4 – ***Christianity and Contemporary Issues*** – Rev. Kenneth Johnson
This course challenges the students to identify and confront contemporary issues. The students will look at issues that affect the church, home and community. They will be encouraged to think through practical solutions and approaches to immediate and emerging social and ecclesiological concerns.

General Assembly Seminar

GAS 001 – ***Christian Character and How it Develops*** – Ophelia Calixte

This course will concentrate on the components of Christian character. Students will identify methods for the growth of Christian character. Case studies will be used to apply biblical principles to contemporary social, economic, and political issues.

Afternoon Courses/Seminars – 1:50 p.m. – 4:20 p.m.

Course # 1097 – ***Survey of I Thessalonians*** – Pauline S. Scott

This course will focus on the book of I Thessalonians, with emphasis on the authorship, date, and recipients of this letter. Students will identify ways that the letter is instructive for application to daily living and the second coming of Christ. This course will be taught in conjunction with II Thessalonians.

Course # 1098 – ***Survey of II Thessalonians*** – Pauline S. Scott

This course will focus on the book of I Thessalonians, with emphasis on the authorship, date, and recipients of this letter. Students will identify ways that the letter is instructive for application to daily living and the second coming of Christ. This course will be taught in conjunction with I Thessalonians.

Course # 3007, Phase 3 - ***History of Baptist*** – Dr. Bentley Thomas

This course will examine the roots of the Baptist faith. Students will study the historical development of the Baptist Denomination.

Course # 9024, Phase 3 – ***Technology in the Life of the Church*** – Evelyn Brown

This course is designed for pastors, office workers, Christian educators and others who want to utilize computer technology in the church. Issues in administration, setting up computer labs, tutorials on Bible study, as well as membership record keeping, and nurture will be covered in this course.

General Assembly Seminar

GAS 002 – ***Understanding the Impact of Our Culture*** – Rev. Kenneth Johnson

This course is designed to present a synopsis of ways that the culture impacts the church. Students will become aware of the various aspects of the culture that are infiltrating the church and will devise strategies to combat this influence. Students will also identify ways to inspire Christians to transform the culture, rather than to conform to the culture.

GAS 003 – ***Becoming an Effective Deacon*** – Dr. W.M. Ramsey

This course is designed to assist the deacon in becoming aware of his biblical base. The students will be presented with ideas that will enable them to more effectively perform their duties and work harmoniously with the pastor and other church leaders.
